Fall is not only the best times at the Hill, but the dropping of the leaves allows us to see much more of the historical Ford estate there. The state of Michigan has designated this section of Highland Recreation area as a Historical site and a designated Natural area. The combination of History and Nature in one setting is just fabulous!

Join us for an extraordinary kind of Hike. We will explore the remains of the Edsel & Eleanor Ford Estate on Haven Hill. We will show you some of what remains of the estate's structures, including the Carriage house, Pool, Kennel, 3,000' Toboggan run, Tennis court, Fountain/Gardens, Fish Ponds and of course the remains of the magnifi-

cent Lodge that once was the home for the Ford family.

This History Hike will be extra special since we will also take you to the Ford Historic Nature Area. A place designed by landscape genius Jens Jensen, for the enjoyment of the Ford family and their guests. This will be the first time that anyone has been able to explore this Trail system. It has taken us almost a year to GPS and



and locate all these trails, features and landmarks. Such as the "Staircase to Mystery Hill", the Ornamental Pool, The Island of Bridges, and many unexplained architectural features still

being explored.

We recommend you wear a good pair of treaded sole shoes or boots for this one, so that you can enjoy all of the explorations of this Hike. We will have detailed Maps and History hand-outs for all in attendance. So join us for a unique afternoon of History and Nature at Haven Hill in Highland recreation Area.
