HAND BIRD FEEDING **HERONS HIKE**

If you have not experienced the amazing Birds out at Kensington Metro Park, then here is your opportunity to do so. The Chickadees, Nuthatches, Woodpeckers and many other species, have become relaxed with the Hikers along the Trails in the Nature Study area. So relaxed that you can hold out your hand filled with various seeds, and they will land

right on your fingertips and eat from your palm. All this takes is a little bit of patience and they will land and feed. There is Bird seeds available for sale at the Nature Center, or you can bring your own. Bring alot, because once you start feeding these Birds from your

hand, it gets hard to stop. :-)

We will be meeting at the Nature Center parking area and heading up to the Center where we will pick up the WILDWING Lake Trail. Also around this trail are many Deer and Sandhill Cranes, Near the end of the Trail we will pass by the Heron island. There are approximately 10 Great Blue Heron nests on this island. The Herons return each year in March to mate and rebuild their existing nests. If we are lucky, we may even spot the infamous White Squirrel, known to roam this Trail.



Don't forget to bring along some Bird Seeds. They are also availible at the Nature Center, and HM will be bringing extra seed for those who arrive early.

Don't forget to bring some Water with you, to keep you Hydrated for the afternoon. Nothing will slow you down quicker, then lack of Water. *Hiking Boots are Required for this Hike. A good pair of treaded sole shoes are recommended. Bring along some Water for yourself. Hat & Gloves are needed. Bring some Bird Feed.

There are a number of ways to get to Kensington Metro Park. The 96 expressway heading west, will take you to either the S.Milford rd. exist, or the Huron River Dr. exit. Head north on either road and just follow the signs into the Park. Then follow the Park signs to the NATURE Center Parking area.
